

DCCC Storm wins a pair of games

Davidson County Community College won a pair of games over the weekend, beating Central Carolina Community College 110-96 in a Tarheel Conference game Saturday at Brinkley Gym and the Belmont Abbey junior varsity 98-81 at Davie County High School on Sunday.

The Storm, 21-5 overall and 6-1 in the conference, will play at Caldwell County Community College next Saturday with the conference's regular-season title on the line. Justin Reissman led the Storm in Saturday's game with 21 points and 10 rebounds. Justin Strickland had 19 points, while Landon Bowers added 16 and W.J. Parks 15. DCCC trailed 53-52 at halftime but came on strong in the second half to pick up the key conference win.

On Sunday, Bowers led the way with 29 points, while Reissmann had 19 points and 10 rebounds. Strickland had 18 points and six assists, and Parks had 13 points. The Storm held a slim 43-39 halftime lead but pulled away in the second half with the help of four 3-pointers from Bowers.
