

ADVISEMENT CHECKLIST PREPARATORY NEEDS

These courses may be required in order for student to have a reasonable chance to succeed in courses applicable to the Associate in Arts or Associate in Science Degree. They cannot be applied to the hours required for the degree, but they do count in the semester load for tuition and status as a full-time student.
