



Associate Degree Nursing Fall 2013 Admissions Information

- DCCC Fall 2013 Associate Degree Nursing Intent Forms will be available in the Enrollment Services office (Mendenhall Building) beginning Tuesday, September 4, 2012. (Included with the intent form will be detailed information about the application, selection, and ranking process and legal considerations related to the nursing program. This process is reviewed annually and is subject to change.)
- Students applying for the ADN program prior to September 4, 2012 should submit the DCCC Application for Admission to begin the ADN support classes and, if required, their preparatory courses. (NOTE: An ADN Intent Form will also be required, once available in September.)
- The ADN program is a full time, day program. Support classes and preparatory classes are available day and evening.
- If an applicant requires any preparatory courses (based upon placement scores), he/she must complete them by the end of Fall Semester 2012.
- ADN applicants must earn a grade of "C" or above in any support courses taken at DCCC by the end of Fall Semester 2012. ("I" [incomplete] grades must be removed by the end of Fall Semester 2012.)
- Applicants must submit the following documentation to Admissions:
 - High school transcript or Adult High School transcript/ GED certificate;
 - Current high school seniors are required to submit a current transcript with their application as well as a final transcript upon graduation;
 - Official college transcript(s) from every college attended;
 - Placement scores within the last 3 years meeting the required benchmark scores in Reading, Writing, Arithmetic, Elementary Algebra and a computer use skills assessment;
 - OR
 - Successful completion of all needed preparatory courses by the end of Fall Semester 2012;
 - OR
 - Successful completion of an approved college level English and/or math class.
 - OR
 - A combination of the above as documented by the Enrollment Office.
- Applicants who have met all of the above requirements by the application deadline will progress to the next step of further assessment and ranking.
- Completion of a Nursing Assistant I program will be required prior to enrollment in the ADN program for Fall 2013. Applicants must successfully complete an approved NA I course (*consisting of at least 70 hours*) prior to the first day of Fall 2013 classes.
- DCCC does NOT maintain a waiting list of ADN applicants from one year to the next. Current DCCC students must demonstrate their intent annually along with all other applicants both new and returning.
- ADN applicants must assume responsibility for confirming that any required documents, scores, and grades have been received by the Admissions Office by the application deadline.
