



Practical Nurse Education, 2013 Admissions Information

- DCCC Practical Nurse Education information for 2013 will be available September 4 2012.
- Students applying for the PNE program prior to September, 2012 should submit the DCCC Application for Admission to begin the PNE support classes and, if required, their preparatory courses.
- The Practical Nursing Program is a three-semester online/hybrid course at the Davie Campus of DCCC in Mocksville, NC. Classes will meet 1-2 nights a week from 6:00 p.m.- 9:00 p.m. for labs and testing. Clinicals will be on Saturdays from approximately 6:30 a.m.–1:30 p.m. Classes may not meet every Saturday, but most will during the first semester. During 2nd & 3rd semesters Saturday and Sunday clinicals will be required. Theory/Lecture is provided online through Blackboard with weekly discussion board entries required.
- You must be an NA I and have a current CPR certification.
- If an applicant requires any preparatory courses (based upon placement scores), he/she must complete them prior to competition for PNE.
- PNE applicants must earn a grade of "C" or above in any support courses taken at DCCC by the end of competition for the PNE class of 2013.
- Applicants must submit the following documentation to Admissions:
 - High school transcript or Adult High School transcript/ GED certificate;
 - Current high school seniors are required to submit a current transcript with their application as well as a final transcript upon graduation;
 - Official college transcript(s) from every college attended;
 - Placement scores within the last 3 years meeting the required benchmark scores in Reading, Writing, Arithmetic, Elementary Algebra and Computer Skills Assessment;
OR
 - Successful completion of all needed preparatory courses by the end of competition for the PNE class of 2013;
OR
 - Successful completion of an approved college level English and/or math class.
OR
 - A combination of the above as documented by the Admissions Office.
- Applicants who have met all of the above requirements by the application deadline will progress to the next step of further assessment and ranking.
- DCCC does NOT maintain a waiting list of PNE applicants from one year to the next. Current DCCC students must demonstrate their intent annually along with all other applicants both new and returning.
