



Library Policies: Computer Usage

DCCC reserves the right to examine and monitor computer usage, computer files, and accounting information and backups generated by use of the computing system and to take action to ensure appropriate use, integrity, and operation of its computing systems. Particularly during hours of peak usage, limits may be placed on the duration and purpose of computer usage.

Limited availability of computing resources necessitates the following user priorities:

- 1) DCCC students, faculty, and staff
- 2) Others affiliated with the College
- 3) Community residents.

All computer users are expected to abide by the College's guidelines:

Computing resources in classrooms, open labs, Learning Resources Center (LRC) and offices are provided to support the teaching, learning, and support functions of the College. Academic use takes priority over personal use across all user categories.

- The College supports the use of its computing and Internet resources for activities such as college education and support services activities
- Other educational/informational pursuits
- Personal communication when computers are available.

The College does not support the use of its computing and Internet resources for activities such as:

- Illegal, commercial, political purposes
- Altering of system files, utilities, or other features
