BUSINESS ENTERTAINING

POLICY 6.3.13

- A.** Consistent with North Carolina's conflict of interest laws and Policy 1.4 – Conflict of Interest, employees may entertain associates and prospective students on the College's behalf with the President's prior authority. When granting authority, the President, or his/her designee, shall approve the type of entertaining and grant expense limits.
- B.** Entertainment expenses will be paid or reimbursed if such expenses are directly related to the College's business and are approved in advance by the President, or his/her designee. Employees who incur entertainment expenses not directly related to College business and/or without the President's approval will be personally liable for said expenses.
- C.** To be approved by the President, or his/her designee, the employee must submit documentation required by the Business Office. The documentation must contain a detailed itemization of the anticipated expenses to be incurred, the date, place and business reason for the entertaining and the names of those participating and their relationship to the College.
